



DomainAnalysis UnitUsageUsers


Total Download by Foreign Country




Top Usage by Country




DomainAnalysis UnitUsageItem Types

Results and Discussions

- Over the 5 years data, the usage is increase gradually. Dramatically in 2022 compared to 2021. The increase is more than 300% (3 times).
- The indexing record in Core UK is low at 32% (18,494) from the total records in UiTM IR.
- Article is the most downloaded item type.
- Subject Education (L) is the most downloaded item.

Recommendations

- The library is able to identify which item type and subject which is highly referred by foreign countries and focuses the effort to collect those research or items to be archived in the IR for referral.
- Limitations of study The number of IR collections indexed in Academic Search Engines such as CoreUK did not have clear criteria on the indexed item. Further investigation needs to be done to identify the criteria for IR collection to be indexed in the system.
- Recommendations for future study Effectiveness of librarian role in expanding IR collections.



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
